Monday, January 9th-14th

Scott and Teresa went to Cosmul in January for 5 days and assisted Prayer Plan Missions with cleaning and making a few repairs at the school in Cosmul. We are so excited to see how God is using the teacher, Nubia, to spread the love of Christ. She is such a woman of faith and is allowing God to use her to provide a quality education to children in the community where she was raised. Please continue to pray for her and all the children in Cosmul, that God will continue to bless them and that His Word will continue to be spread to this young generation in Honduras. We also want to pray that as many children as possible in Cosmul will be able to benefit from a quality education at this school.

In addition to cleaning and doing a few repairs with PPM, we also packed up many books that were sent to Copan to be used by teachers there, as well as eight sewing machines that will be such a blessing at the new training center.

Saturday, February 4th-18th

In February, Allison and Teresa set out for a week in Copan delivering school supplies to teachers and children. Then, Teresa continued on for another week in the area of Comayagua, specifically in Chaguatillos and the surrounding villages. The teacher supplies included a bag filled with all kinds of materials including a stapler, sharpies, wipe-off markers, paper, rulers, markers, pens, liquid glue, and many other useful items. A total of 32 bags were distributed. The children were given bags with a pencil pouch/box, crayons, colored pencils, pencils, erasers, stick glue, and pencil sharpeners. 100 Kinder Bags were distributed to little ones; 570 bags were distributed to children in 1st through 6th grade; 28 bags were distributed to 7th-9th grade youth, and 15 bags were distributed to 11th & 12th grade youth. That is a total of 713 bags of school supplies given to children and youth in the areas of Copan and Chaguatillos. A total of 13 schools received bags of student supplies and 15 schools received supplies for the teachers.
