

PEH, Inc. is gearing up for two trips in September and October. In September, we will be working in three different schools to do repairs. If we have time, we will start on repairs at a fourth school. In October, we will be cleaning and making repairs at the training center. The training center is going to be used to teach specific skills that will offer individuals more opportunities when searching for a job to support themselves and their family. Most children drop out of school by 3rd grade and, as such, job opportunities are very few. However, this training center will give hope to many people that otherwise would have very few opportunities to learn a new skill. Things such as sewing, welding, carpentry, masonry, and terrace gardening are all programs that have been discussed. In addition, we hope that it can be used for bible studies and retreats to spread the word of God. There is so much to be done. However, each step of the way, God is guiding us in where to go, when to go, and what to do.

We continue to work alongside our friends and other missionaries in Honduras. However, for us to continue the work we are doing, we do need financial support. We are budgeting \$6,000.00 for the trips in September and October combined. Also, for one individual to go to Honduras, it costs about \$1700.00 in the fall. We are inviting others to join us to help us with the repairs, see what God is doing, and spread his love amongst our friends in the region of Copan. Please contact us if this is something you feel God is calling you to do. PEH Team Members and the Co-Directors who go to Honduras typically pay for all their expenses as well. However, we would like to off-set those expenses. Our top priority, however, is in raising the funds for the repairs.
