Truly, He is at the center of everything we are doing, and we are committed to keeping Him in the driver's seat. Sometimes, however, it seems that it is hard to keep up with Him. In just 3 years, it is crazy to think about all that He has done! Oh, what an amazing journey it continues to be!

We began 2025 with our annual School Supply Distribution. However, it turned into something much more. This year, because of God's provisions and bounty, we were able to bless the children and teachers with so much more than just supplies. Just take a look at what God has done:

625 Children and 33 Teachers in schools near Copan Ruinas received School Supplies

625 Children received Vitamins daily and Anti-parasites twice a year

9 Schools received Clean Water Systems and First Aid Kits

A feeding program was begun in all 9 of our schools

325 backpacks, 68 pencil pouches, and 15 teacher bags were also distributed in Comayagua









## **Growth of the Feeding Program**





Last year, through the help of HEA, we approached Kenny Posas, the pastor of Pena de Horeb, and asked him if he would be willing to help us start a feeding program in the 9 schools to which God had led PEH. Pastor Kenny is very passionate about meeting the needs of the least, the last, and the lost, and in his church reaching out into their own community. He began a feeding program several years earlier called The Matthew 28 Project and knew how to feed large numbers of children. Pastor Kenny was excited to work alongside of us, and to expand the feeding program. In addition to the 9 schools where PEH is serving, 6 other schools received daily food throughout the school year, which was from February to November. With the help of Honduras Evangelical Association and a couple other individuals in Honduras, the Body of Christ came together and 87,240 plates were served. Please continue to pray with us as God continues to use many ministries to work together to meet the needs of His children in Honduras, as well as to spread the Gospel.

#### **2025 PEH TEAMS**

We are so grateful for all four of the teams that traveled to Honduras in 2025. From distributing school supplies in February, to repairing buildings, painting, VBS, and Teacher Training, we have been non-stop. We could not do it without all the individuals who said, "Yes!" to going and being the hands and feet of Jesus! Dates for 2026 have been decided! Prayerfully consider if God is calling you to be a part of what God is doing in Honduras.



### God visioned it, and then, it happened... Teacher Training!

For several years, Honduras Evangelical Association and Project Education Honduras have talked about training teachers to teach the bible in the schools. Much prayer and many conversations have been occurring. Then, in February of 2025, the first training occurred and 60 teachers came. The session included topics such as, "Why should we teach the Bible to children and youth?" "What should we teach?" and "What should a lesson include?" Teachers received songs to teach, as well as a list of memory verses. Every teacher who attended received a bible for themselves, as well as a children's bible. We had a follow-up session in July and then, repeated the February session in October. Teachers from our schools have attended, as well as many teachers from other schools, and individuals from villages who are working with children and youth. It has been incredible to see God's plan literally explode in front of us. Currently, curriculum is being written that will be shared with the teachers in January. The curriculum will give teachers a story each day of school to teach the children, as well as scripture that they can teach alongside the values that the government requires them to teach in school. Praise be to God for all He is doing to make Jesus known in the very poor villages in Honduras.







# The Body of Christ at Work!

We are forever grateful for all the individuals and ministries that God has put in the path of Project Education Honduras. Honduras Evangelical Association and Pastor Kenny Posas and his church, Pena de Horeb, have become great friends and partners in ministry. All of us working together has been absolutely incredible. It is the very definition of what an Acts 1:8 church should be globally, each one of us using our passions and skills, working together to bring Jesus to the ends of the earth and for Pena de Horeb to their Jerusalem. We are also gratful for the continued support of Mayor Jose Alcalde of Cabanas, who has assisted in mobilizing the community of Miramar to build the new school, as well as with purchasing supplies. We are eternally grateful for Confesor, a leader in the community of Miramr who lives nearby and oversaw the construction. The building is beautiful!









## So much more has happened in 2025!

In addition to beginning the feeding and medicine program, as well as the clean water program, we have continued to do small projects in the schools. This year, we rennovated the school at San Isidro, fixing the windows and adding new doors, as well as giving it a fresh paint job inside. With the help of PEH funds, the community is going to paint the outside before school begins in the fall. At Miramar, in addition to a new building, we also renovated the old building, putting new screen in the windows and a new door. The new building, as well as the old building and bathrooms. also got a fresh coat of paint.

While completing the projects, we also shared the Gospel. Anytime we visit a school, no matter how long we are visiting, we always share the Word of God. Our goal is simple – to develop relationships and make disciples of Jesus Christ. We don't just go to give things and renovate and build schools. We go to spread the good news of Jesus Christ, and we stick around. We have developed many beautiful relationships over the past 3 years, and we are so grateful to God for choosing us to be a part of His plan.















## A Personal Message from Dennis and Teresa

As we near the end of 2025, we can hardly believe all that God has done since we said, "Yes!", a little over three years ago, to His plan for us in Honduras. We are humbled to have been called into this ministry and to be serving among so many gracious and Godly people, whom we love and call our friends and family. We are 3 full years into ministry, and God has built 2 new buildings and completed renovations at 7 schools, some of which were major repairs. In addition, the training center and several schools have been freshly painted. We have presented the Gospel, a four-day VBS, at 5 schools and shared the Word of God multiple times in all 9 of our schools. This year alone, Miramar is receiving a new, 3 classroom building, and funds have been allocated for a building at Hacienda San Juan. The construction in that village will begin this month, and the plan is for it to be completed by February. 625 children are being fed daily and receiving vitamins and medicines. One of God's biggest miracles was the beginning of teacher training. Due to this training, the word of God is being taught each day to children at school, and this initiative is growing in strength and numbers. Praise be to God! All of this is because of individuals such as you who are so faithful in praying and encouraging us in ministry! Please continue to pray as we continue to go where God sends us and do what He asks us to do!

### What is next for PEH?

God is calling us into a new phase as we continue to develop relationships in the schools where He has led us. In 2026, we will continue to focus on building relationships with the ministries with whom we partner, as well as the communities and teachers where we are serving. We will also continue spreading the Gospel in the schools through VBS and Teacher Trainings. In addition, we will continue to make improvements to the schools and provide support and encouragement to the teachers.

PEH will also be implementing a new system for donor support called Donor Perfect. Because PEH is growing so quickly, we feel it is time to move to a larger platform that also helps us in better communicating with those who have been supporting us through their prayers, as well as their finances. With this new platform, we will also be giving individuals an opportunity to support the feeding and medication programs in specific schools and build relationships with the teachers in a specific school. More about this will be coming with end-of-year statements. Details will also be published on our website and social media.

Finally, we hope to continue to expand the number of individuals who come and serve with us in Honduras.
