

I went over to the boxes that contained the bags of school supplies, and I prayed for a "loaves and fishes" miracle. The team then began to hand out the bags. At one point, I looked around and Carol Lynne had 3 bags in her hand, and Marcela and I had just enough for the remaining boys. Listen carefully to what God did... 3 LEFT OVER ... the exact amount we needed in order to give

backpacks to friends of the mission. We began this entire journey thinking God would provide for 700 children. In the end, He provided for 839. A modern day miracle and testament to how God works. With prayer at the center, He will provide in His Way, His Timing, and with His Plan! Amen!
