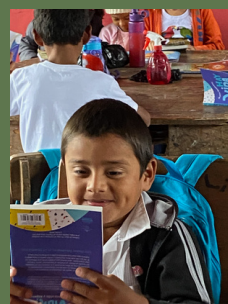

Each student in 7 different villages received a pencil pouch with colored pencils, crayons, pencils, pens, little erasers, big erasers, pencil sharpener, crayons, and glue sticks. This year, we focused on how God made each one of us special and for a special purpose. This year, we were also able to give each child a New Testament Bible. Most of the children have never had their own bible, and for them, it is a very special gift.

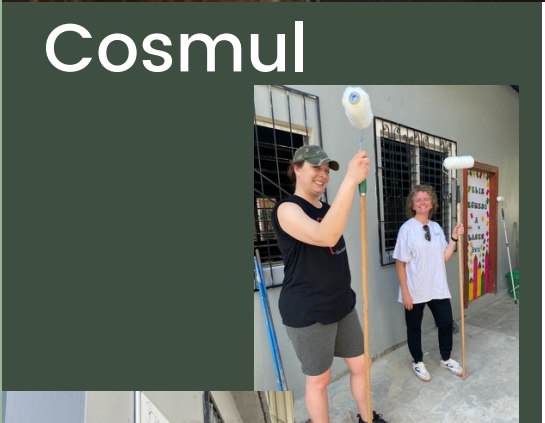
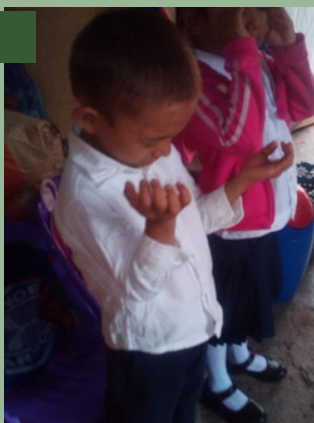

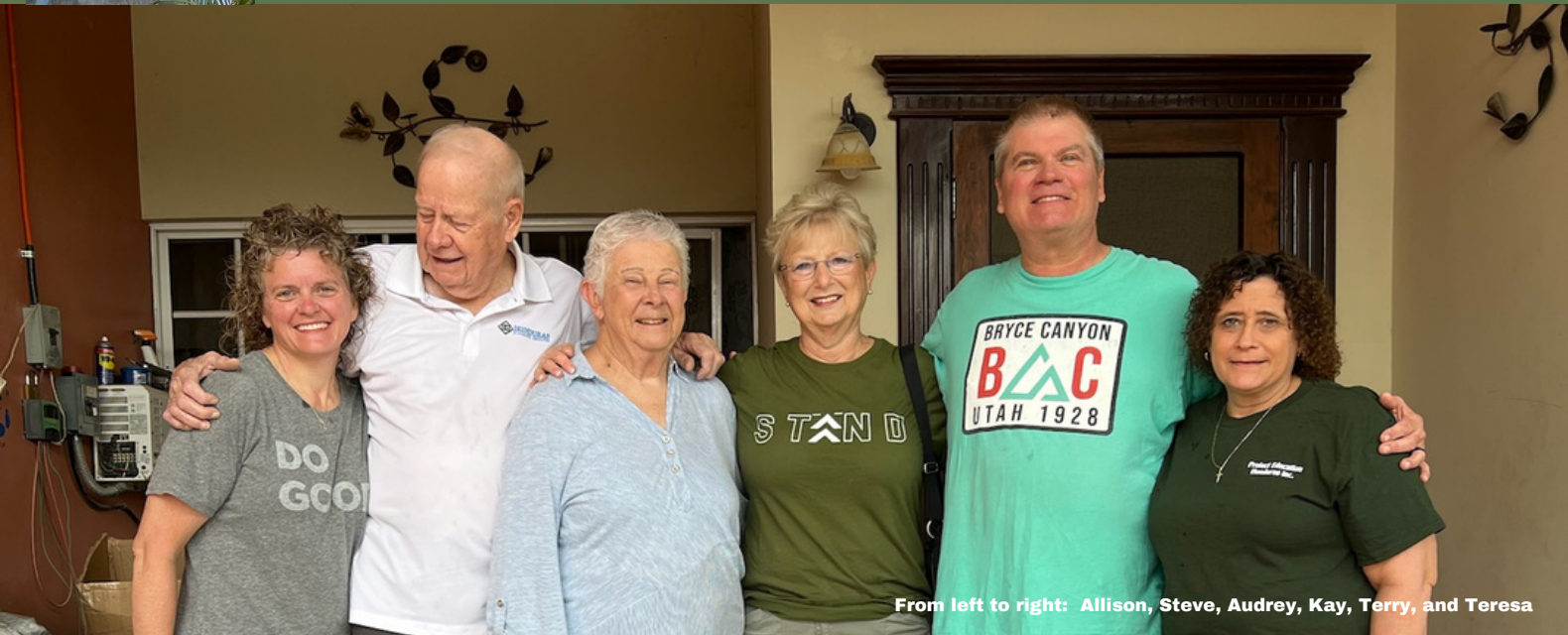
